Dress Code: Dress is semi-casual and show clothes are optional. ASTM-approved helmets are encouraged. Due to high temperatures, the Judge may allow short-sleeved collared shirts at her discretion.

Equipment: USEF/WD rules and guidelines will be used for attire and equipment.

Health Requirements:

Out of State Horses: Please ensure you have the appropriate documentation for your horse(s) per the Ohio Department of Agriculture. <http://www.agro.ohio.gov>

ALL horses from out of state must have a current Coggins Test

Fees

(No refunds after closing date.)

Office Fee: \$25 per entry (horse/rider combination) **4-H members are exempt from paying office fee.**

Non-Competing Horse: \$25 Plus office fee, stabling, haul-in fees,

Stalls: \$25 per day plus \$25 deposit. \$50 for Friday and Saturday, plus \$25 deposit. \$75 for Friday, Saturday and Sunday, plus \$25.00 deposit. Deposit is refundable once stall has been cleaned.

Limited number of stalls available. Stalls will be assigned on a first come served basis.
No Tack Stalls Available.

Haul-in: \$10 (Horses not having a stall).

Late Entry Fee: \$10 if post marked after Closing Date – April 18, 2026.

Returned check fee: \$50

Post Office Visit Fee: \$20 will be added to your mailed entry if it requires a signature.

Judge's scores are final: Show management reserves the right to combine, split or cancel classes as needed.

Exceptional Riders: Must submit a completed WDAA Statement of Eligibility for Exceptional Rider Classes. This applies to both Physically Challenged and Therapeutic Riders.

Show Office: Will be open Friday 3-7 pm, and from 7am Saturday until an hour after the show closes.

Facility/Test/Entry Information

Facility: All tests will be ridden in a 20X60 outdoor ring, and the ring will be reduced to a 20X40 for the Intro and Basic Levels. The footing is sand. Lunging is only allowed in the designated area. Two rings will be utilized if entries warrant it. Dogs must always be on leashes.

WDAA Dressage Tests: WDAA 2022 version

Divisions:

Junior - Under 18 as of Dec. 1, 2025

Adult Amateur - 18 and over as of Dec. 1, 2025

Open - Professionals, Adult Amateurs and Juniors

Test limit is six per day per horse. This does not include suitability or dressage seat equitation.

Horses can only compete in two consecutive levels.

A horse may be ridden by different riders, but only 6 tests in total. Horse/rider combinations may ride the same test twice at the same competition, given that they are separate class numbers. No horse may be ridden more than once in any Western Dressage class including separate sections of the same class number. Horses may be ridden in junior, amateur and open sections at the same competition. Horses cannot be ridden by more than two riders.

2026 OHWDA Horse Show High Percentage Awards

High Percentage Award: Eligibility for the OHWDA A competitor must ride in at least 3 of the OHWDA 2026 shows. The competitor's top percentage from each show will be added together to determine the average. If a rider has competed in more than 3 shows, their top three scores from different shows will be used, with the lowest score(s) being removed. The awards will be by division: Open, Amateur, Junior, Physically Challenged and Therapeutic.

Further Clarification: A competitor is defined as the same horse and rider combination.

2026 OHWDA End of Year Award Program

The Ohio Western Dressage Association offers a Year End Award Program to current members of OHWDA. An overall highpoint award is awarded in each division and individual level high point awards in each division. Levels: Intro, Basic, Level 1, Level 2, Level 3, Level 4 and Level 5. WDAA Awards Programs

OHIO LIABILITY RELEASE AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

I AGREE that I chose to participate voluntarily in the Ohio Western Dressage Association Schooling Show and/or Ohio Western Dressage Association or sponsored activities. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horseback riding and equine activities carry inherent dangerous risks of accidents, loss, and serious bodily injury. In accordance with the Ohio Equine Liability Act, Ohio Revised Code 2305.321, I do hereby acknowledge the following INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES:

- a) The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death or loss to person on or around the equine;
- b) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, to other animals;
- c) Hazards, including, but not limited to, surfaces or subsurface conditions;
- d) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object;
- e) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other person, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.
